21. Activities of IQAC during the period:

A) IQAC: As per the guide lines of NAAC, the college has constituted an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) for performing the following functions of the college:

- Development and application of quality benchmarks/Parameters in various activities of the institution.
- Organization of discussion, workshops, seminars and promotion of quality circles.
- Recording and monitoring quality measures of the institution.
- Preparation of the Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQAR) and other such reports as may be decided from time to time.

B) RED RIBBON CLUB: The college has a Red Ribbon Club Unit since 2010 and has been organizing various types of awareness programmes such as Aids Awareness Rallies and Blood Donation Camps, putting up posters on Aids Awareness, doing surveys and talks on Aids Awareness in rural areas. All the members of the Red Ribbon Club actively participate in organizing awareness against consuming alcohols, tobacco and consumption of drugs. The Club arranged a rally on 1st December, 2017 on the occasion of International Aids Day.

C) ECO CLUB: The college has an active Eco Club. Both teachers and students can be members of the club. The members organize literacy programmes in connection with the World Literacy Day, Environmental Awareness Programme on the occasion of the World Environment Day. They also arrange seminars and discussions from time to time related to the club. In the year 2017, the club arranged a programme of planting medicinal plants in the college campus.

D) THE WOMEN CELL: The college has a women cell called MAHASHWETA (Cell for Women's Studies). The Cell has been organizing seminars, discussions, talks etc concerning various problems of women and on the interest of women empowerment. The Women Cell of the College organized International Women's Day on 8th March 2018. On this occasion the wall magazine CETANA was inaugurated by Dr. Dibyajyoti Mahanta (Dean, KKHSOU, Assam) and he also delivered a speech on "Need of Gender equity in Assamese Society". Advocate Arup Phukan, Dibrugarh Bar Council, Dibrugarh delivered a speech on "Domestic Violence and Women Empowerment". Dr. Gayatri Gogoi, Cancer Specialist of Assam Medical College, Dibrugarh delivered a speech on "Cancer as a Challenge: Empowering Women to overcome the Challenge"

E) RESEARCH CELL: The research cell of the college organized a one day workshop on "Research Methodology and Preparation of Research Proposal" on April 28, 2017. The Teachers of the College published research papers and attended Seminars, Workshops etc. encouraged by the Research Cell. The research cell conducted a visit to a plastic factory situated at Jamirah Beheating on April, 2017 with the students of BA 5th Semester.. A field study on 'Health and Sanitation' at Pani Gaon, Barbaruah, Dibrugarh dated 2nd April, 2017 in collaboration with Department of Sociology was organized by the Research Cell. F) MUSIC CELL: Music cell of the college encourages the musical activities of the students as well as the teachers. It tries to enhance the musical talents of students and teachers. A classical vocal music class in organized by the music cell every Monday. It is open for all interested students.

G) SAHITYA CHORA: The college has a SAHITYA CHORA, to develop various literary skills of students and teachers. The SAHITYA CHORA organizes various discussions, talks,

workshops and celebrates the occasions of the great literary persons from time to time. The cell also organizes different literary programmes, competitions and takes initiative for books, Journals publication.

H) CULTURAL DEPARTMENT: The college has a cultural Department to develop various cultural talents of students and teachers. K) COLLEGE WEEK CELEBRATION: Keeping in view the aim of all round development of the students, the college celebrates this occasion annually with the help of the Cultural Department, SAHITYA CHORA & the Music Cell of the college. The college organizes various competitions in different areas such as—

N) Health Awareness Programme: N.L.B. City College and Shruti Shilpi Samaj jointly organized a health awareness programme titled **CANCER IS A CHALLENGE** on Cancer and Tuberculosis Awareness and also organized a free medical checkup in collaboration with Deepshikha Cancer Foundation, Mumbai. City College organized a Aids awareness rally on 1st December, 2017 on the occasion of International Aids Day.

O) Silver Jubilee: The college organized the opening ceremony of Silver Jubilee on 20th August 2017. 22. Activities of Student Counseling and Guidance Cell

NCC wing of the college: The National Cadet Corps is the Indian Military Cadet Corps with its headquarters in New Delhi, India. It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization which recruits cadets from high school, colleges and universities all over India. The cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades.

The NCC wing of the college was introduced on the August 2006 under 10 Assam BN NCC Dibrugarh. Initially the total number of NCC cadets (including boys and girls) was 30 (thirty). The present strength of the NCC wings is 56 (fifty six). It is a great opportunity for the students who join the NCC as there are many scopes for jobs for NCC cadets in our country. The NCC provides various rigorous trainings like weapons training, drills, various arms training, firing training etc. The NCC cadets of our college attended many camps like ATC, RDC, NIC, BLC etc. in different parts of India. The NCC wing of the college also observes NCC day in the month of November every year. It is mentionable that the NCC cadets get more job opportunities than others.

- v) IMA Camp: 1 Cadet of the College took part at the Army Training Camp held at Dehradoon.
- vi) NIC Camp: 20 Cadets of the college took part in a National Integration Camp held all over India.
- vii) Tracking: 20 Cadets of the college took part in a Tracking Camp held all over India.
- viii) Shooting: 12 Cadets of the college took part at Shooting Camp.
- ix) ATC Camp: 8 Cadets of the college took part at the Army Training Camp held at Dinjan
- x) CATC Camp: 52 Cadets of the College took part in a Combined Annual Training Camp held at various places of Assam.
- xi) Games: 8 Cadets of the college took part at the NER Games held at Shillong .

NSS: The Birth of NSS (National Service Scheme) was in September 1969 during Gandhi Centenary year and during 4th Five Year Plan 1969-74. The Motto of NSS is NOT ME BUT YOU which means the overall objective of NSS is to develop the students personality through community services for social well being. The specific objectives of NSS Volunteers are to kindle the student's social consciousness. To give them opportunities and to work with and among the people ; to develop awareness and knowledge of social realities; to have a concern for the well being of the community, particularly of the weaker sections; to engage themselves in creative and constructive social work; to put their scholarship to practical use in mitigating at least some social problems and in promoting welfare; to gain skills in the exercise of democratic leadership; to gain skills in the programme of development for self involvement during leisure and vocation period of National Development and to enrich personality. For these activities the N.S.S. volunteers have to Provide N.S.S. Badge and N.S.S certificate which will stand volunteers in good stead in future career. Therefore, it is a great opportunity for the students who join the N.S.S.

Our college N.S.S wing was introduced about 48 years back, i.e. in 2005 of National Scheme. The present strength of NSS volunteers of our college is 100. Among them, there are 50 boys and 50 girls. From the starting, NSS wing in this college have been performing social services in different fields.
